Whew!

### *But...why?*

Because where the building will be located, the ground is about 2 feet lower than the road. The land development plan calls for this area to be almost even with the road...not just to improve the site's aesthetics and prominence of the building...but to ensure there are no 100-year flood plain 'issues.'
